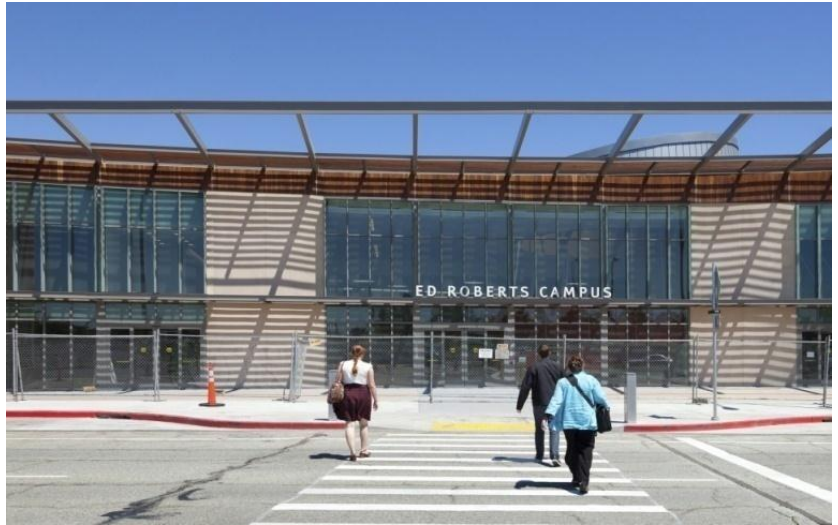


Ed Roberts Campus



The Ed Roberts Campus (ERC) is a new 80,000 square foot, two-story building which houses the offices of collaborating organizations with a focus on the Independent Living/Civil Rights Movement of people with disabilities. The ERC is designed and built to set a new standard of accessibility through the principles of universal design, acknowledging that our built environments are used by people of all ages and abilities. The building is also an example of Transit Oriented Development, and the ERC has a direct connection to the Ashby BART station at 3075 Adeline Street in Berkeley.

- Multi-tenant nonprofit center focused on disability rights and services
- Model for accessible design
- BART and transit access
- Gracious common areas for meetings, conferences, events, and interaction
- Energy efficient lighting and systems
- Café on ground floor

The ERC is 85% leased and seeking like-minded nonprofit organizations for the remaining office suites.

Suite: 270 – 4,115 rentable square feet

Rent: \$6,585 per month (\$1.60/SF) plus reimbursement of operating expenses estimated at \$3,374 per month (\$0.82/SF).

Tenant Improvements: An allowance will be provided to apply toward tenant improvements.
